

# Thetford Planning Commission Vacancy Notice

The Planning Commission is Thetford's committee for citizen involvement on development and land use issues and has been working tirelessly on revisions to our outdated Town Plan. There are five volunteers currently serving and they're looking for two more!

The current members of the Planning Commission would love a Commission that represents all geographical areas of Thetford and now have representation from East Thetford, Thetford Hill, Thetford Center, and Post Mills. So – all you eager volunteers from North Thetford, Union Village, Rices Mills, and, the Steven's District, please come forward! However, all interested parties from anywhere in Thetford are encouraged to apply! At their May 14, 2018 meeting, the Selectboard will review all letters of interest and appoint two volunteers. The Planning Commission has been actively working to recruit volunteers to serve with them and have had to slow their work and cancel some meetings due to lack of a quorum. Because of this situation, if there are no volunteers for these open seats, the Selectboard will, at its May 14, 2018 meeting, consider reducing the required number of commission members from seven to five. This will mean fewer voices around the table to hear and discuss development and land issues for the Town of Thetford.
