Selectboard Town Plan Hearing

The Selectboard continuation of the first hearing to discuss the draft Town Plan was called to order by Stuart Rogers, Selectboard Chair, at 7:00pm on September 7, 2017. Jessica Eaton will conduct the meeting and the review will pick up where the review left off at the August 24 hearing, Chapter 5. If anyone present has comments from the first four chapters, they were encouraged to present them to the selectboard via email.

Jessica led the discussion of the remaining chapters, taking questions and comments from the audience. Submitted written comments were read aloud by Jessica Eaton. At the end of the review, Jessica Eaton explained there will be a second Public Hearing, the date of which has not yet been determined. The Selectboard will discuss the draft, comments received and possible changes. Any changes will first be distributed to the Planning Commission with a request for a written report on how the requested changes would change the submitted draft Town Plan. Stuart Rogers pointed out the Selectboard is required to have two public hearings; they could have more than two.

Stuart Rogers said the Selectboard discussion of the Draft Town Plan will be on another evening, not at a Selectboard Monday Regular Meeting; possibly on September 20th, in an open meeting. It would be a warned meeting which will be open to the public. They have invited comments from several other parties, including Thetford Elementary School, Thetford Academy, GMEDC and local law enforcement.

A motion to adjourn was made by Stuart Rogers. The motion was seconded by James Dixon. The motion passed unanimous at 9:55pm
